JANKYN AND THE WITCH'S DAUGHTER

for ages 5 and upwards

A unique and vibrant gypsy tale from Romania about a young man and his heroic quest to keep the girl he wants to marry. A story of disguise and discovery and seemingly impossible tasks as the girl of his dreams - the daughter of a witch - disappears almost as soon as she is miraculously found. Keeping her from the evil clutches of her mother nearly proves to be an unattainable task! This story is performed using puppets and objects, woven together with driving rhythms from a range of instruments - the dilroba (an Indian stringed instrument), kemence (the Turkish Violin) and Middle Eastern Percussion.

Look out for: The 8 foot high goddess **ISIS** (Harvey's Puppet Show, Hornsea) in the Town Centre and **SARASWATI**, dancing marionette from India (Indigo Moon, Beverley) at the Market Cross.
